



FREE CROCHET COOKED TURKEY HAT PATTERN

Sizes

- Toddler/Preschool 2-5 years (head circumference 19 inches or 48 centimetres)
- Child 5-10 years (head circumference 20 inches or 51 centimetres)
- Tween 10-14 years (head circumference 21 inches or 53 centimetres)

Materials

Any worsted weight [4] will work.

- 1 ball Red Heart Comfort Putty
- 1/3 ball each Loops & Threads Impeccable in Claret, Pumpkin, Gold, and Forest
- 1/3 ball Vanna White in Taupe
- 4.0mm crochet hook
- 5.0mm crochet hook



Toddler

Round 1: using brown and 5.0mm hook, chain 3 and make 8 DC in 2nd chain from hook, join (8)
Round 2: ch 2, 2 DC in each DC, join (16)
Round 3: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next*, join (24)
Round 4: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 2*, join (32)
Round 5: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 3*, join (40)
Rounds 6-14: ch 2, DC in each DC, join (40). Fasten off.



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Earflap 1

Row 1: Ch 2, HDC 10, ch 2, turn (10 HDC)

Row 2: HDC decrease, HDC in next 6, HDC decrease ch 2, turn (8 HDC)

Row 3: HDC across, ch 2, turn (8 HDC)

Row 4: HDC decrease, HDC in next 4, HDC decrease, ch 2, turn (6 HDC)

Row 5: HDC across, ch 2, turn (6 HDC)

Row 6: HDC decrease, HDC in next 2, HDC decrease, ch 2, turn (4 HDC)

Row 7: 2 HDC decreases, ch 2, turn (2 HDC)

Row 8: HDC decrease, fasten off (1 HDC)

Earflap 2

Leave 11 stitches along the front. Begin the second earflap

Row 1: Ch 2, HDC 10, ch 2, turn (10 HDC)

Row 2: HDC decrease, HDC in next 6, HDC decrease ch 2, turn (8 HDC)

Row 3: HDC across, ch 2, turn (8 HDC)

Row 4: HDC decrease, HDC in next 4, HDC decrease, ch 2, turn (6 HDC)

Row 5: HDC across, ch 2, turn (6 HDC)

Row 6: HDC decrease, HDC in next 2, HDC decrease, ch 2, turn (4 HDC)

Row 7: 2 HDC decreases, ch 2, turn (2 HDC)

Row 8: HDC decrease, ch 1, turn (1 HDC)

SC around the entire outside edge of the hat in Taupe, join to first SC, fasten off

Child/Tween

Round 1: using brown and 5.0mm hook, chain 3 and make 8 DC in 2nd chain from hook, join (8)

Round 2: ch 2, 2 DC in each DC, join (16)

Round 3: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next*, join (24)

Round 4: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 2*, join (32)

Round 5: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 3*, join (40)

Round 6: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 4*, join (48)

Rounds 7-15: ch 2, DC in each DC, join (48). Fasten off.

Teen/Adult

Round 1: using brown and 5.0mm hook, chain 3 and make 8 DC in 2nd chain from hook, join (8)

Round 2: ch 2, 2 DC in each DC, join (16)

Round 3: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next*, join (24)

Round 4: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 2*, join (32)

Round 5: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 3*, join (40)



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Round 6: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 4*, join (48)

Round 7: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 5*, join (56)

Rounds 8-15: ch 2, DC in each DC, join (56). Fasten off.

Earflaps for Child/Tween and Teen/Adult

Row 1: Ch 2, HDC 12, ch 2, turn (12 HDC)

Row 2: HDC decrease, HDC in next 8, HDC decrease, ch 2, turn (10 HDC)

Row 3: HDC across, ch 2, turn (10 HDC)

Row 4: HDC decrease, HDC in next 6, HDC decrease, ch 2, turn (8 HDC)

Row 5: HDC across, ch 2, turn (8 HDC)

Row 6: HDC decrease, HDC in next 4, HDC decrease, ch 2, turn (6 HDC)

Row 7: HDC across, ch 2, turn (6 HDC)

Row 8: HDC decrease, HDC in next 2, HDC decrease, ch 2, turn (4 HDC)

Row 9: 2 HDC decreases, ch 2, turn (2 HDC)

Row 10: HDC decrease, fasten off (1 HDC)

Earflap 2

Leave 16 stitches along the front. Begin the second earflap

Row 1: Ch 2, HDC 12, ch 2, turn (12 HDC)

Row 2: HDC decrease, HDC in next 8, HDC decrease, ch 2, turn (10 HDC)

Row 3: HDC across, ch 2, turn (10 HDC)

Row 4: HDC decrease, HDC in next 6, HDC decrease, ch 2, turn (8 HDC)

Row 5: HDC across, ch 2, turn (8 HDC)

Row 6: HDC decrease, HDC in next 4, HDC decrease, ch 2, turn (6 HDC)

Row 7: HDC across, ch 2, turn (6 HDC)

Row 8: HDC decrease, HDC in next 2, HDC decrease, ch 2, turn (4 HDC)

Row 9: 2 HDC decreases, ch 2, turn (2 HDC)

Row 10: HDC decrease, ch 1, turn (1 HDC)

SC around the entire outside edge of the hat in Taupe, join to first SC, fasten off



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Wings

Make 2

R1: using 4.0mm hook and brown yarn, make a magic circle, ch 2, 8 HDC, join (8)

R2: ch 2, HDC in each stitch around, join (8)

R3: ch 2, *2 HDC in next HDC, HDC in next 3*, join (10)

R4-6: ch 2, HDC in each stitch around, join (10)

R7: ch 2, *HDC 2 together, HDC in next 3*, join (8 HDC)

R8: ch2, *2 HDC in next HDC, HDC in next 3*, join (10 HDC)

R9: ch 2, *2 HDC in next HDC, HDC in next 4*, join (12 HDC)

R10-16: ch 2, HDC in each stitch around, join (12 HDC). Stuff wing to the desired firmness, ensuring that it can bend in half.

R17: ch 2, *HDC 2 together*, join (5 HDC). Fasten off.

Bend in half and sew in place on the inside that will be attached to the hat.

Sew each wing onto the hat with the back of the wing centred over the ear flap, about 5 or 6 rows up from the base of the hat.

Drumsticks

Make 2

Round 1: using brown and 4.0mm hook, make a magic circle, ch 2, 8 HDC, join (8)

Round 2: ch 2, 2 HDC in each HDC, join (16)



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Round 3: ch 2, *2 HDC in first HDC, HDC in next*, join (24)
Round 4: ch 2, *2 HDC in first HDC, HDC in next 2*, join (32)
Round 5-12: ch 2, HDC in each stitch around, join (32)
Round 13: ch 2, *2 HDC tog (decrease), HDC in next 2*, join (24)
Round 14: ch 2, HDC in each stitch around, join (24). Stuff the drumstick so far.
Round 15: ch 2, *2 HDC tog (decrease), HDC in next*, 2 HDC tog (decrease), join (16)
Round 16-17: ch 2, HDC in each stitch around, join (16)
Round 18: ch 2, *2 HDC tog (decrease), HDC in next*, HDC, join (11)
Round 19-23: ch 2, HDC in each stitch around, join (11). Add more stuffing to the drumstick.
Round 24: ch 1, SC 3 tog (decrease) twice, SC 2 tog (3). Fasten off and weave in ends.

Roast Vegetables

I used Twinkie Chan's instructions as a base but made some tweaks, as written below.

Cherry Tomato

R1: using 4.0mm hook and red, ch 3 and sl st to 1st ch to form a ring, ch 1 and work 6 sc into ring, join (6)
R2: *2 sc in next st* 6 times, join (12)
R3: *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* 6 times, join (18)
R4-6: ch 1, sc in each sc around, join (18)
R7: ch 1 *sc 2 tog (decrease), 1 sc in next st*, join (12) add stuffing
R8: ch 1, *sc 2 tog (decrease)*, join (6)
Fasten off and weave through remaining 6 sts with a tapestry needle. Pull to close. Tie off and weave in end.

Tomato Top

R1: using 4.0mm hook and green, ch 3 and sl st to 1st ch to form a ring, *ch 3, skip the 1st ch, sl st in each remaining 2 chains, sl st in ring to join* 5 times
Fasten off leaving 2 inches of yarn. Tie the beginning yarn and end yarn into the tomato and knot it. Bury the thread in the tomato OR leave a longer end yarn and sew it to the top of the tomato. Weave in ends.

Baby Carrot

R1: using 4.0mm hook and orange, ch 3 and sl st to 1st ch to form a ring, *ch 1 and work 6 sc into ring, join (6)
R2: ch 1, *2 sc in next st*, join (12)
R3-4: ch 1, sc in each sc, join (12)
R5: ch 1, *sc 2 tog (decrease), sc in next 4*, join (10) add stuffing
R6: ch 1, *sc 2 tog (decrease), sc in next 3*, join (8)



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R7: ch 1, *sc 2 tog (decrease), sc in next 2*, join (6)

R8: ch 1, *sc 2 tog (decrease)*, join (3), fasten off leaving a 5 inch tail, weaving through the remaining 3 stitches with a tapestry needle, pull to close, weave in ends.

Carrot Top

Using 4.0mm hook, sl st green through top center of carrot, bringing the hook back up through R1 of the carrot, join.

R1: ch 5, sk 1st ch, and sl st in each of 4 remaining chs. Insert hook through top and center of carrot again and bring hook back up through R1 of Carrot, skipping 1 space first.

The 6 sc's of R1 create 6 spaces for you to insert your hook. You'll only be using 3 spaces to make 3 leaves, so that's why you skip 1 space. Then sl st to join.

Repeat R1 2 more times. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Potato

Using 4.0mm hook and gold, ch 3 and sl st to 1st ch to form ring.

R1: ch 1 and work 6 sc into ring, join (6)

R2: ch 1, *2 sc in next st*, join (12)

R3: ch 1, *2 sc in next st, 1 sc each in next 3 sts*, join (15)

R4-9: ch 1, sc in each sc, join (15)

R10: ch 1, *sc 2 tog (decrease), sc in next 3*, join (12) stuff

R11: ch 1, *sc 2 tog (decrease)*, join (6)

Fasten off leaving a 5 inch tail, weaving through the remaining 6 stitches with a tapestry needle, pull to close, weave in ends.

Arrange the vegetables how you like and sew them to the hat in coordinating yarn and tapestry needle.

Braids

Make 2

Cut three 20in (51cm) strands of each (9 strands total): colours light brown, dark brown, red
Fold in half, pass through the last loop at the base of the ear flap (18 strands to braid with).

Make a knot. Separate colours into 3 groups of 6, braid.

Loop knot at the end. When both braids are affixed and complete, line them both up even and trim ends.
