



FREE CROCHET TURKEY HAT PATTERN

Sizes

- Toddler/Preschool 2-5 years (head circumference 19 inches or 48 centimetres)
- Child 5-10 years (head circumference 20 inches or 51 centimetres)
- Tween 10-14 years (head circumference 21 inches or 53 centimetres)

Materials

- 1 ball Vanna White's Taupe
- 1 ball each Loops & Threads Impeccable in Claret, Pumpkin, Gold, and Forest
- I also used a small amount of Black and White yarn that I had on hand for the eyes
- (any worsted weight [4] will work)
- 4.5mm crochet hook





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Toddler

Round 1: using brown and 4.5mm hook, chain 3 and make 8 DC in 2nd chain from hook (8)

Round 2: ch 2, 2 DC in each DC (16)

Round 3: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next* (24)

Round 4: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 2* (32)

Round 5: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 3* (40)

Round 6: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 4* (48)

Rounds 7-13: ch 2, DC in each DC (48)

Round 14: change to red, ch 1, sc in each DC (48)

Round 15: change to orange, ch 1, sc in each SC (48)

Round 16: change to gold, ch 1, sc in each SC (48). Fasten off.

Child

Round 1: using brown and 4.5mm hook, chain 3 and make 8 DC in 2nd chain from hook (8)

Round 2: ch 2, 2 DC in each DC (16)

Round 3: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next* (24)

Round 4: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 2* (32)

Round 5: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 3* (40)

Round 6: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 4* (48)

Round 7: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 5* (56)

Rounds 8-15: ch 2, DC in each DC (56)

Round 16: change to red, ch 1, sc in each DC (56)

Round 17: change to orange, ch 1, sc in each SC (56)

Round 18: change to gold, ch 1, sc in each SC (56). Fasten off.

Tween

Round 1: using brown and 4.5mm hook, chain 3 and make 8 DC in 2nd chain from hook (8)

Round 2: ch 2, 2 DC in each DC (16)

Round 3: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next* (24)

Round 4: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 2* (32)

Round 5: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 3* (40)

Round 6: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 4* (48)

Round 7: ch 2, *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 5* (56)

Round 8: ch 2 *2 DC in first DC, DC in next 6* (64)

Rounds 9-16: ch 2, *DC in first 2 DC, DC in next 5* (64)



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Round 17: change to red, ch 1, sc in each DC (64)

Round 18: change to orange, ch 1, sc in each DC (64)

Round 19: change to gold, ch 1, sc in each DC (64)

Beak

R1: using gold and 4.5mm crochet hook, chain 2, sc in 2nd chain from hook (1)

R2: turn, ch1, 2 sc in next sc (2)

R3: turn, ch1, *3 sc in next sc* (6)

R4: turn, ch1, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4, 2 sc in next sc (8)

R5: turn, ch1, sc (8). Continue to sc around the side (4), 3 sc in bottom sc, and final side (4). Join and fasten off.

Using black thread that is doubled, make 2 angled stitches to form nostrils. Affix to hat after eyes are centred and sewn on the hat.



Wattle

R1: using red and 4.5 mm hook, chain 3, sc 4 in 2nd chain from hook (4) join, ch1

R2: 2 sc each sc (8) join, ch1

R3-6: sc each sc (8) join, ch1

R7: *sc2tog, sc in next 2* (6) join, ch1

R8: *sc2tog* (3) join. Fasten off leaving a 5" tail to sew on to the hat. Place on or beside the beak.



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Eyes

Make 2

R1: using black and 4.5 mm hook, make a magic ring, chain 2, DC 6 (6) join, ch2, tighten the ring to close

R2: using green, DC 2 in each DC (12), join, ch2

R3: using white, SC 2 in each DC (24), join. Fasten off leaving a 10" tail to sew eye to hat.

Feathers

Make 10

R1: using brown and 4.5 mm hook, chain 2, sc in 2nd chain from hook (1)

R2: turn, ch1, 2 sc in next sc (2)

R3: turn, ch1, *3 sc in next sc* (6)

R4: turn, ch1, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4, 2 sc in next sc (8)

R5: turn, ch1, sc across (8)

R6: turn, change to red, ch1, sc across (8)

R7-8: turn, change to orange, ch1, sc across (8)

R9-11: turn, change to gold, ch1, sc across (8)

After all 10 have been made, take 2 with wrong-sides together (right sides facing out) and single crochet in brown all around. Ensure you do 3 sc in each corner. In the last corner, 2 sc and join. Fasten off.

Once 5 feathers have been complete, attach to the hat by spacing evenly in a "fan" display. Sew the brown section to the hat with the coloured parts peeking over the hat, unsecured.
